1. Should we pay taxes

to Caesar?

Jesus shows that we should give

ourselves

to God, and obey the government
(unless it asks us to do something
against God)

2. Whose wife will someone

be in the resurrection?

Jesus says the new

creation will

be very different from life now.

3. What is the

greatest

commandment in the law?

Jesus says love God and

love other people.

In all these answers, Jesus is showing that the people asking the questions don't love and

respect God as they

should.

Then to finish, Jesus asks them a question:
"What do you think about the

Christ?"

Jesus is the Christ, God's anointed

King, standing right in front of them, but they can't see it.

Talk with your grown up about who Jesus is. Pray that you would see he is the Christ and would trust and love him.
