death. Our bible passage helps us to

remember that this is **not** a

made-up story, but something that really

happened and it

helps us see that this is really important
for how we live our lives.

Our first heading is:

Jesus really **rose** from the

dead:

In our passage, Paul says it is really, really

important that Jesus **died** for

our sins, that he was buried and that he
was raised.

He also says that this was even

talked about in the Old

Testament before Jesus was even born!

But Paul knows that it might be difficult

for people to **believe**

that Jesus came back to life, so he tells his

readers that there were still people alive who had seen Jesus alive again!

Our Second heading is:

Christians really

rise from the dead:

Jesus rising from the dead gives hope that we will rise from death if we

trust in Him. If Jesus had not

been raised from death, then our faith doesn't make any sense.

But Jesus did rise and so we need to

live like he did.

Think with your grown up about what that means. Maybe it helps us to share our toys as the things we have in this life aren't going to last forever, but our friendship with Jesus will.

Maybe it means we don't need to be afraid in scary situations because we know that Jesus is with us and even if the worst happens to us, we will be with Jesus forever in heaven and that will be so much better than life here.

Pray, asking God to help you live like this.
