


We can read the bible, like the two children in the picture, to learn how to obey and worship God.

Today in Leviticus chapter ten, something bad has happened and God is about to show us how he feels about it...

### Their Sin

Aaron's sons, Nadab and Abihu didn't worship God in the way He had

**commanded** them to.

The people of **Israel** had done this before when Aaron and the people built a golden calf to help them worship **God**.

This was not what God commanded. He hated it. God tells **Christians** how

He wants us to worship Him in the bible.

### God's response

When Nadab and Abihu disobeyed God, the fire of His glory appeared and it

**consumed** them (that

means it completely destroyed them!)

The Lord wanted His people to know that His commandments must not be ignored.

God is **holy** and He wants us to treat Him that way by obeying Him.

### The faithful priest

Aaron and his sons had two jobs. One was to separate what was holy from what wasn't.

The other job was to preach the **law** of God. This was so God's people would draw near to Him.

Now, we have Jesus as our High Priest, but God has also given us teachers and elders to

**preach** God's Word so we can

meet the Lord Jesus as we read the

**bible.**

Chapter ten teaches us how holy God is and how important it is to obey Him.

When we **obey** God, we can enjoy being in His presence.
