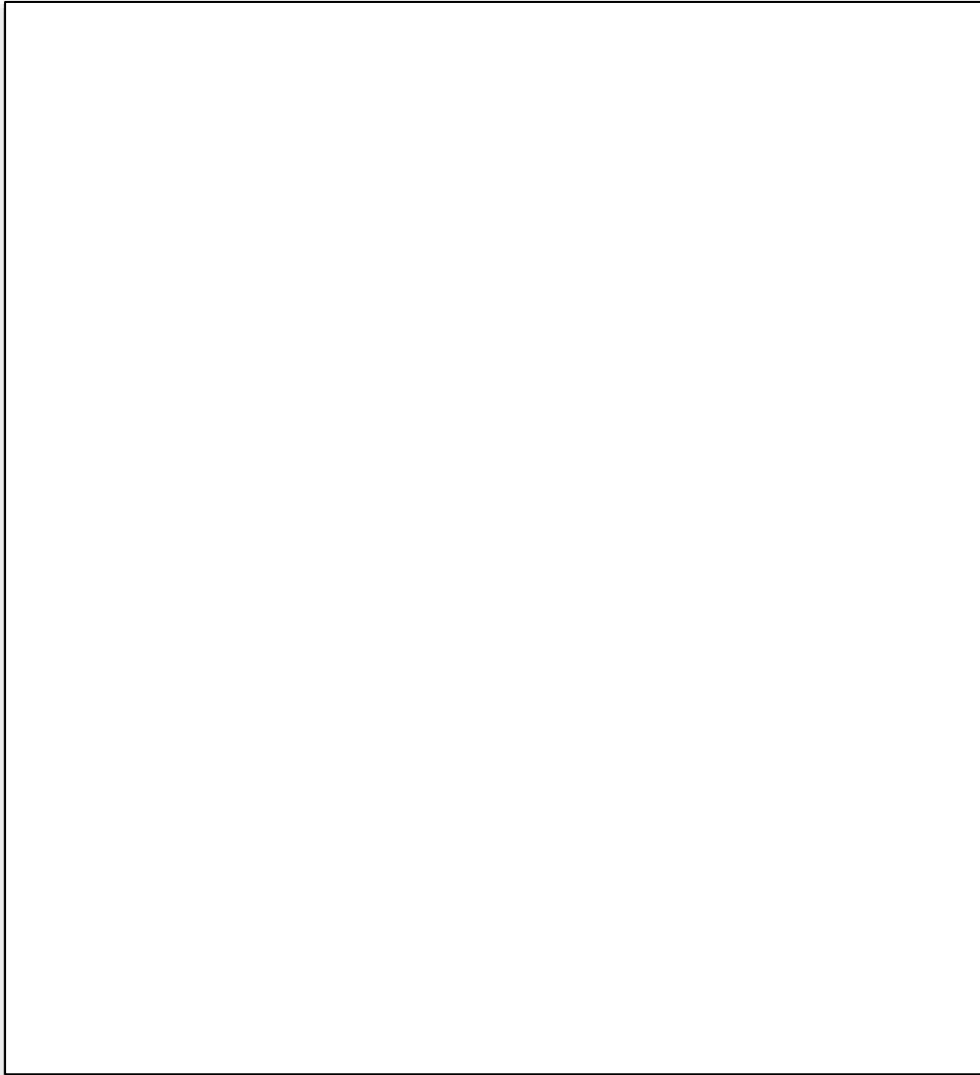


Think of how you can obey God even though it is hard.
