


1 Peter, chapter 4 tells us to "arm ourselves". We should be ready to fight sin when we are tempted. Colour the picture below.



Today we are in 1 Peter, chapter 4.

Peter tells us that because Jesus suffered on the cross, we can say **no** to sin.

Jesus' suffering also means that when we suffer, we can glorify God by doing things that He calls **good**.

Entrust Ourselves to God...  
Peter tells us to be ready for **battle!**

When we are tempted to sin, we can **fight** against it.

When Jesus died on the cross, He  
**defeated** sin. He helps us to  
say no to sin so we can live lives that glorify  
God.

...while doing Good  
One day we will all stand before God. He will  
**judge** how we have lived as His  
people in this world.

God is pleased when we **love** and serve  
one another.

Ready to Rejoice as we Share Christ's  
Suffering  
Suffering as a Christian is normal.

When we suffer because we are followers of  
**Jesus**, we don't suffer on our own-  
Jesus is with us.

When we suffer for Jesus' name, we can have  
**joy** because we know we belong to Him.

God will judge everyone. If we have put our  
**trust** in Jesus, we will be  
**saved**. But if we have not put our  
trust in Jesus, we will not be saved when He  
judges us.

and serve God and other people.*
