
## The Laws of Moses – being God's holy people

# 1. God gave laws that provided a special meeting place with Him

- Exodus 24 Leviticus 10
- A covenant with Yahweh:
   "I am the LORD" (e.g. Leviticus 11:44-45 etc)



### 2. A critical need: God's people must be "sanctified"

• The "climax" of the Law

Leviticus 26:11-12, "I will make my dwelling [tabernacle] among you, and my soul shall not abhor you. And I will walk among you and will be your God, and you shall be my people."

The need for holiness: "Be holy, as I am holy" (Leviticus 11:44 etc)

Leviticus 10:10, "You are to distinguish between the holy and the common, and between the unclean and the clean"

- Everything that is not holy is common.
- Common things divide into two groups: the clean and the unclean.
- How do you become holy? "I am the Lord who sanctifies you" (Leviticus 20:8 etc)

### 3. Laws that provide for the sanctification of God's people

- Laws about being "Clean" (Leviticus 11 15)
  - → What do we do with these laws? Think about...
    - Jesus' incarnation...
    - the Gospel story...
    - our obedience
- Laws about being "holy" (Leviticus 17 22)
- Laws about the "times" when you met with God (Leviticus 23 25)

#### 4. Covenant conditions... and a better covenant

- God promised blessings and threatened curses (Lev. 26 / Deut. 28)
- Israel blessed... then cursed → New covenant
- The new covenant is NOT different...

The Mosaic covenant was gracious
The New covenant also requires repentance and faith (Matt. 12:37, James 2:21)
God's call to holiness has not diminished... & we're to obey the moral law

The new covenant IS different...

The period of time in which the Levitical system "worked" ended with the coming of Jesus (Galatians 3:25, 4:6)

The Law's burdens have been removed:

- The yoke of circumcision and food laws Acts 15:10-11
- Repetitious nature of the sacrifices Hebrews 10:11
- Deaths of the high priest Hebrews 7:23
