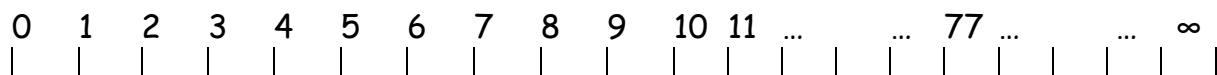


Listen carefully to the Bible reading

Let's try and see the difference between 10,000 talents and 100 denarii. Which do you think is a **LOT** and which do you think is a little?

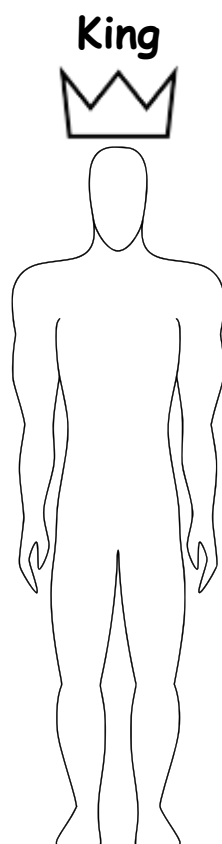
Can you see the big box around this page?

If the first servant owed the king as much as this big box, the second servant owed the first servant as much as this little dot here → · (can you see it?)

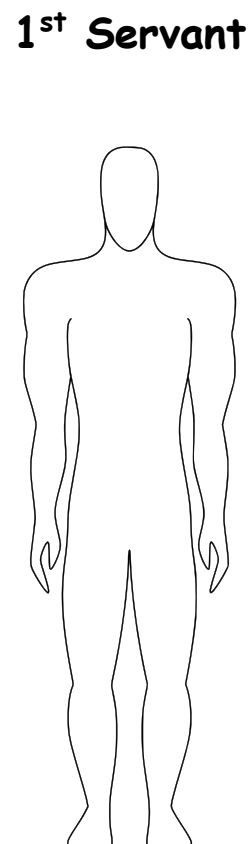
What words describe the king and the first servant?
