Judgement

Judgement parables are hard to hear, but to help us we need to see the

majesty and love of

God. That's what we see at the start of this

parable: The King is God the

Father. He loves his son, Jesus

and wants him to be

honoured so he

prepares a feast and sends out his servants and they say

Come to the feast, come to

your God and his son. What an

amazing invitation,

but the people will not come! So they will face

God's right judgement.

Next we see that the King's feast will be

full with others, that's great news,

but then we learn, there's a man not wearing

wedding clothes. He

is also rejecting the King. So he too will be judged. It is serious to reject God's king.

It's hard to hear parables about God's judgement, but Jesus talks a lot about it so we need to listen. Say a prayer with your grown up asking God to help you listen to his warnings in the bible and thanking him for his kindness in sending Jesus.
