help us think about this, Jesus told three

more parables.

Each parable has a delay and

then an unexpected return and then a

division. We're going to

look at each parable in turn:

Parable 1: The loving servant who

cares for his Master's

people. We are like this servant, we need to

think about who we have been

given to care for, maybe a little

brother or sister?

Who can you share a bible story with?

Parable 2: The prepared virgins who

stay ready

for the Bridegroom.

The bridegroom takes a long time to arrive,  
but the wise virgins are

prepared for the  
wait. We need to be like them.

Parable 3: The eager servant who

works for Jesus' kingdom.

In the parable, two servants do the work of  
God's kingdom and are

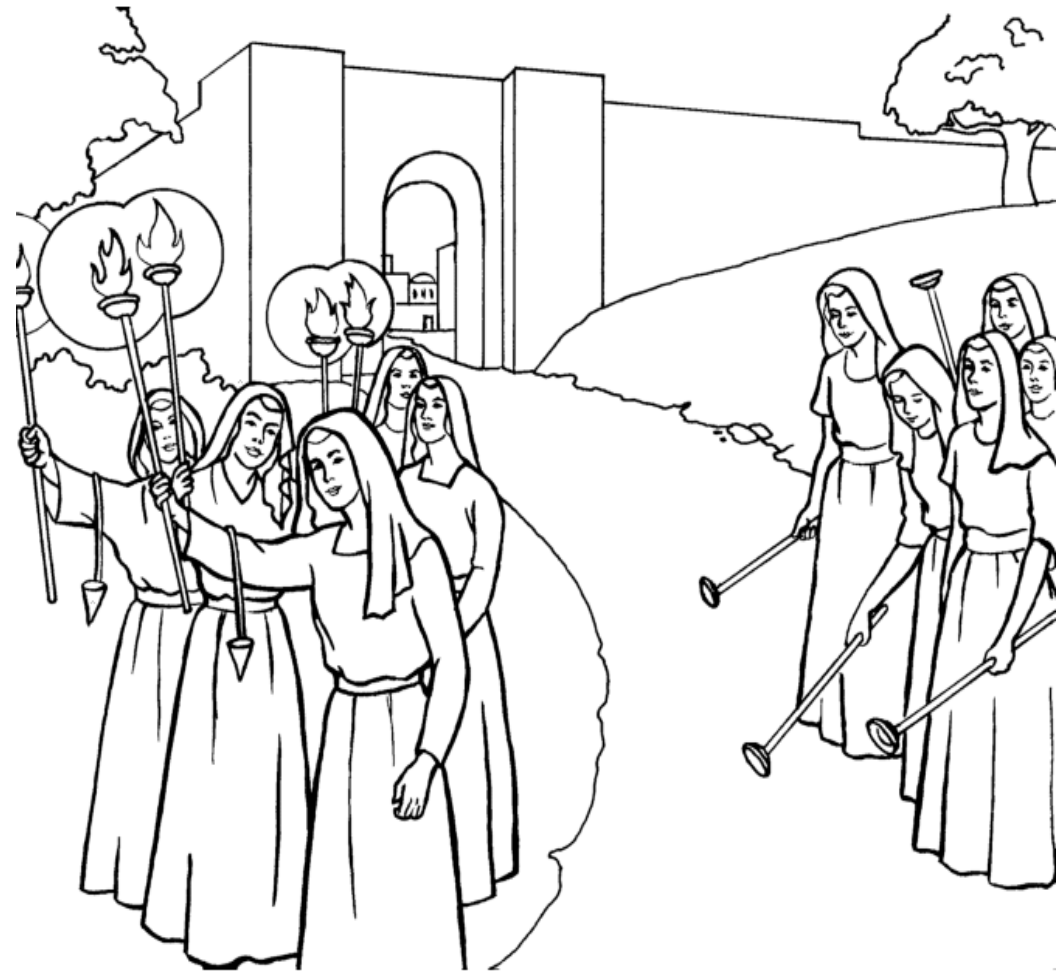
rewarded and

one does not and he is punished. We want to  
be like the servants who work for Jesus'

kingdom, sharing the good

news about Jesus wherever we are.
