

In our passage today we're going to see

the **leaders** of God's

people, the priests, having a job review by God. And we are going to see they were

falling at the job God

had given them. So, God rebukes and

curses Israel's priests.

The reason for this was because they were

not **teaching** the

people how to obey God's law and

showing them

how to do this in the way they lived. This meant that God's people were

sinning and turning

away from God.

God also tells the priests what a

faithful priest should

be like. They should

honour God in

everything they do by making sure they do

it **right** and by teaching the
people how they can approach a holy God
through making the right

sacrifices . But

what does this mean for us? We

don't have priests and

sacrifices any more but we do have Jesus

who is the **perfect**
priest and the perfect sacrifice and the

way we can approach God

now. And he also shows us how to live to
please God.
