

Listen carefully to the Bible reading from 1 John chapter 2 verses 28 to 3 verse 10

We are going to think about what God wants for Christmas, and why God planned for Christmas in the first place.

So let's see what the Bible says about why Jesus came.

This week we'll think about 1 John chapter 3 verse 8:  
"...The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil."

Look at the whole of 1 John chapter 3 verse 8 in your Bible. What does it say the devil has been doing since the beginning?

He is God's enemy and he wants to keep people away from God. He wants to keep people in sin.

BUT - Jesus has come to destroy the works of the devil!

So how does he do this?

We'll see three ways Jesus does this.

If we are a Christian today, these are three things we can say:

"Jesus has made me God's child"


The devil works to keep people away from God. Jesus destroys his work when he makes us God's children!
