trusting God. It

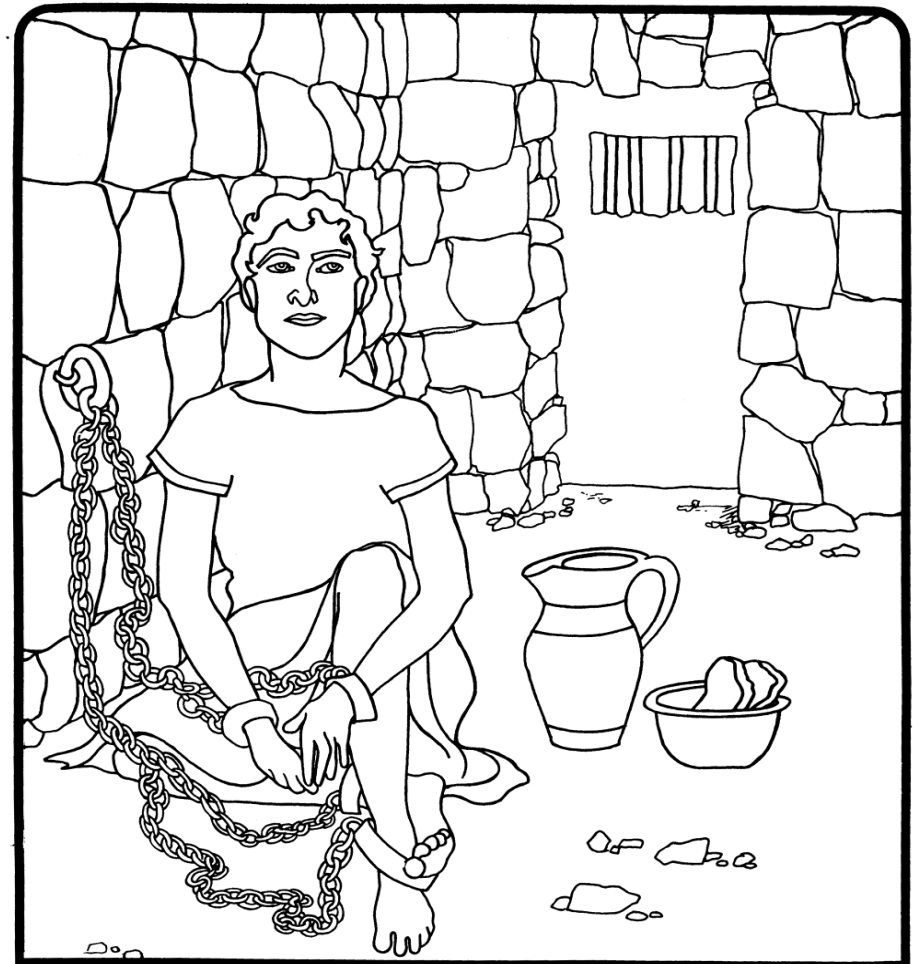
seems that the bible idea of success is faithfulness.
