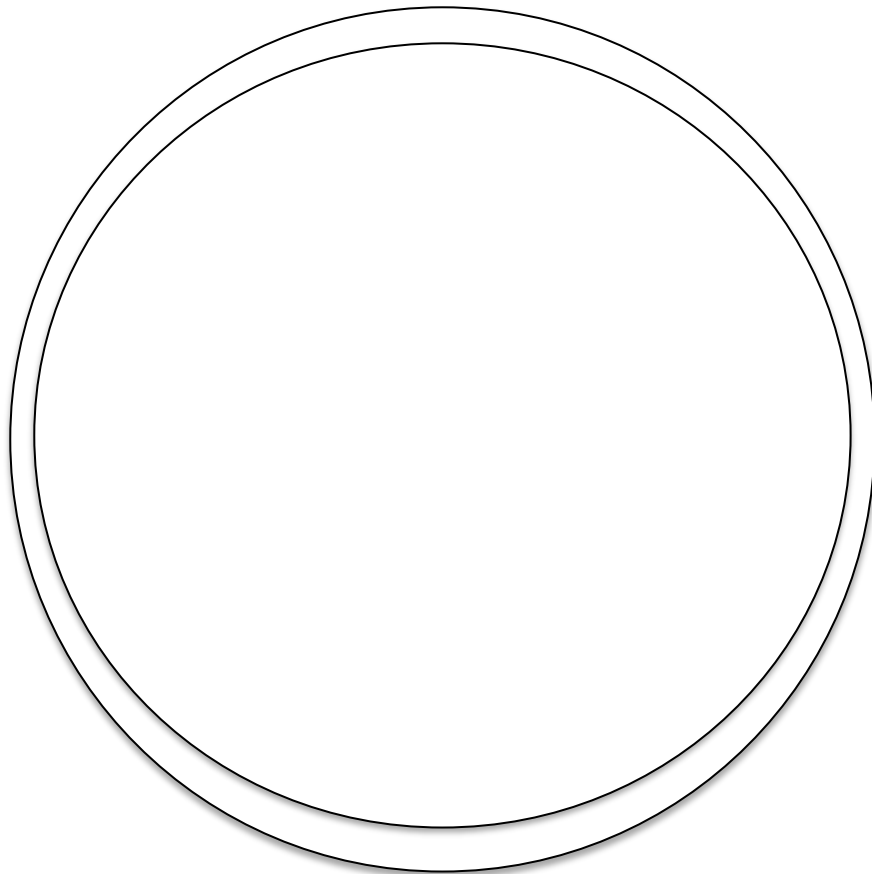


One way we can make an effort to help other Christians is by cooking them a meal.

John loved Gaius because he **believed** the truth and lived it out.

Gaius made an effort to **support** gospel work (other Christians telling people about Jesus) by **helping** other Christians in

different ways. He should keep doing this and we can find ways to do this too!

Normal, faithful Christians should be careful about who they copy

We all copy people sometimes! John reminds us to copy good things instead of bad things.

A man called Diotrephes wasn't making an effort to support other Christians. He was a bad person to copy. He wasn't living out the truth.

But, there was a man called Demetrius who had been changed by the truth. He lived a righteous life (the way the bible teaches us to live). He was a good person to copy.

Christians should live out the truth about Jesus every day.

Living out the truth will give us great joy.

Pray with your grown-up, asking God to help you live out the truth we know about Jesus and the Gospel, and have great joy doing it.
